We are looking for dynamic registered nurses to join our team.</p> <p>ACENS is a community-based service that provides care to adults with exceptional and complex health needs who live throughout the Lothians. Offering patients and their families the best care and experience possible, the team works in partnership with patients, families, Social Work, and the wider MDT providing up to 24 hour, 7 days a week care tailored to the individual’s needs.</p> <p>ACENS staff work as a lone worker but as part of a wider team. Staff have continual access to indirect support. This is a very rewarding post enabling patients to live in their home environment and access the wider community.</p>
Duties and Responsibilities	<p>You will work within the team providing hands on care to patients and assist with training and supervision of junior staff. In line with registered nurse duties, you will act as the nurse in charge of the shift in the absence of a team leader.</p> <p>Patient needs are varied and can include invasive/non-invasive ventilation, airway management, enteral feeding, complex and unique epilepsy and or other complex neurological conditions.</p> <p>In addition to your clinical skills, we are interested in your passion for working in healthcare and your commitment to delivering excellent patient centred care, as well as a demonstration of personal values aligned to those of our organisation.</p>
